### *Welcome to Our Church House*

The excitement of growth and development is in full swing and due to the vision of meeting the needs of our Cathedral Church and School, construction continues on the Early Childhood Development Center, the Family Activity Center and the Cathedral Bell Tower. It makes accessible to students participation in the liturgy and the sacraments, which are powerful forces for the development of personal sanctity and for the building of community. It provides a more favorable pedagogical and psychological environment for teaching Christian faith.
